



## CCART 16<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY ART SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS & GUIDELINES

CCART is a non-profit organization in support of the visual arts. The primary goal is to provide visual art scholarships to talented high school seniors residing on the Lower Eastern Shore of Delaware, Maryland and Virginia seeking continued education to the school of choice in the study of visual arts. Scholarships and awards have ranged from \$500 to \$2,000; 7,000 in scholarships were awarded in 2015. Scholarships will be awarded during the second semester as long as the recipient is in good academic standing.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Eastern Shore (Maryland: Caroline, Dorchester, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, & Worcester; Delaware: Sussex; Virginia: Accomack & Northampton) high school seniors planning on majoring in visual arts.
- High school transcript: 2.5 average or higher.
- Evidence of application to a university, 2 or 4 year college or other programs that lead to the study of visual arts.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

Student Personal Information Form (form enclosed):

- Biographical information about the student, information about the high school(s), academic and non-academic art studio experience, awards and honors.
- A statement describing the student's art related background and career goals for pursuing this award/scholarship.
- Release Form.

### OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT (SEE NOTE BELOW).

### LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION (2 FORMS ENCLOSED)(SEE NOTE BELOW).

At least two letters of recommendation from a qualified art-related professional (e. g. teachers, employers, internship supervisors, etc.).

**NOTE:** The school transcript and two letters of recommendation can be submitted with the Student Personal Information Form in sealed signed envelopes or sent separately by deadline.

### PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS

- **CONTENT:** The portfolio must consist of **sketch-books** exhibiting development in their art and no less than 5 original works to an unlimited number of originals or appropriate copies demonstrating competence in at least two media.
- **SPECIFICATIONS:** A portfolio of actual two-dimensional work and/or actual three dimensional work, e. g. drawings, painting, prints, sculpture, etc., from either high school or college art classes or other art instruction will be reviewed by CCART. If original three-dimensional works are unavailable, photographic examples could be submitted in three-dimensional views (sides and top), no less than 5" x 7" color photographs, or other means of viewing such as DVD video or computer disk/CD. Please provide your own laptop for viewing CD/DVD. Internet WiFi will not be available.

**DEADLINE for Student Personal Information Form, transcript and recommendation letters is Friday, MARCH 25, 2016, by 5:00 p.m. Applications must be received by this deadline. These forms should be mailed to: CCART, P. O. BOX 4194, SALISBURY, MD 21803-4194.**

### PORTFOLIO AND INTERVIEW SCHEDULE (LOCATION TBA)

CCART will review Student Personal Information Forms. Students will then be notified by phone of the time for their individual interview and portfolio review at the Arts Institute & Gallery, Salisbury, MD. Students will be scheduled for Sunday, April 10, 2016, beginning at 9:00 a.m. (a 2-day scheduling is based on the number of applicants). Portfolios will be reviewed only during the scheduled interview and released immediately following student interviews.

Any of the forms used in this application process may be duplicated.

Scholarships will be awarded in full in the second semester of school attendance with verification of good standing.
